



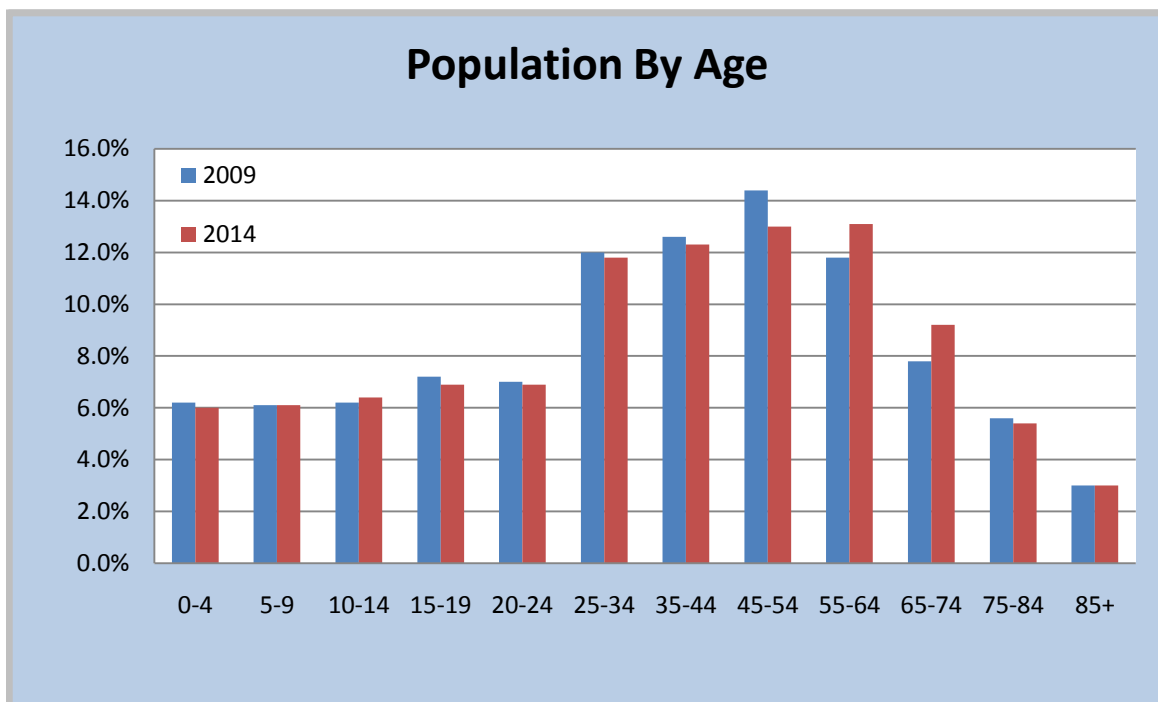
Northwest WIA Region Demographic Summary

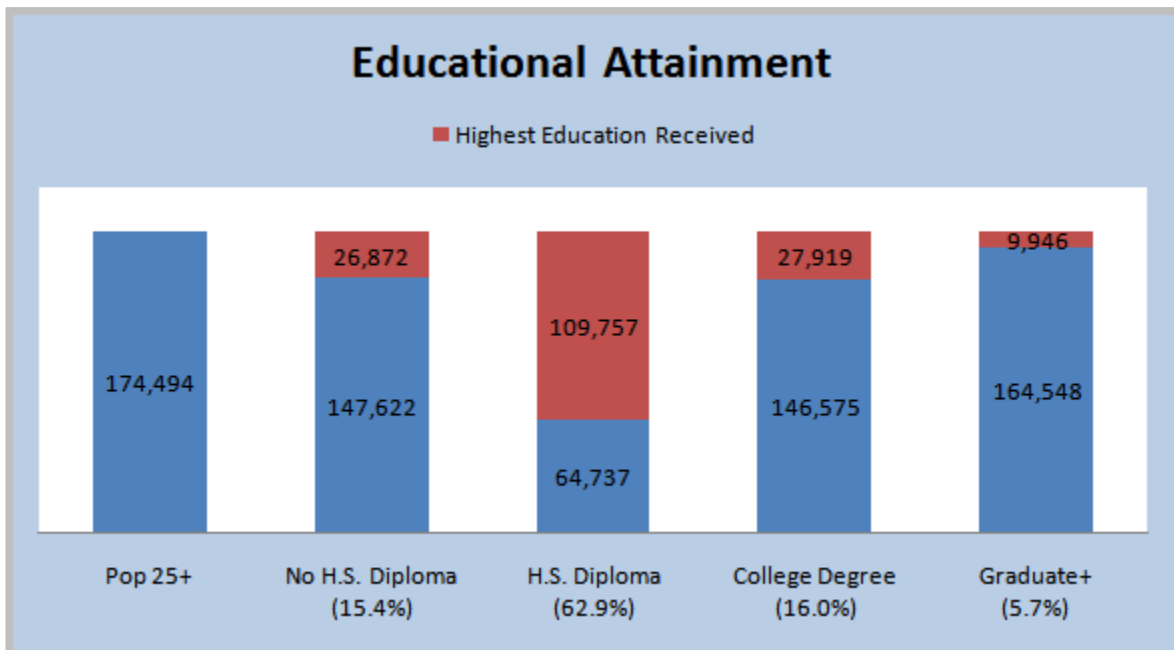
