



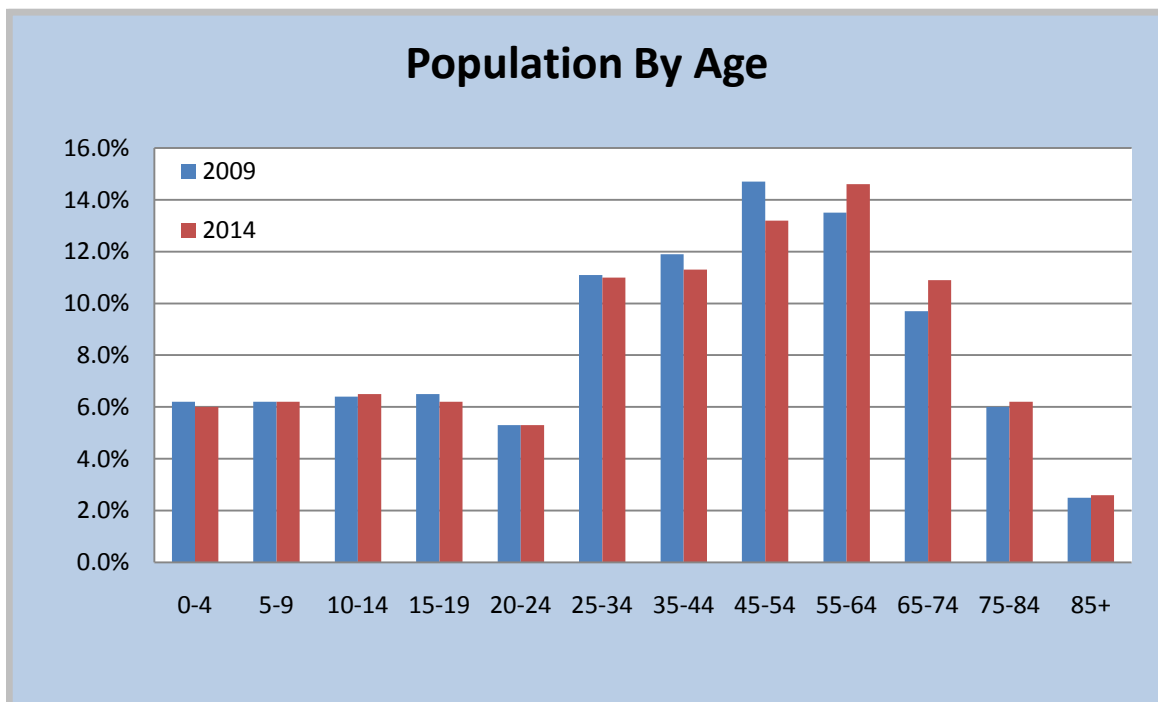
# South Central WIA Region Demographic Summary

The South Central region is projected to grow slowly in population over the next five years. The least populous of the regions, South Central is projected to have a median age of 42.8 by 2014 which would be the highest in Missouri. 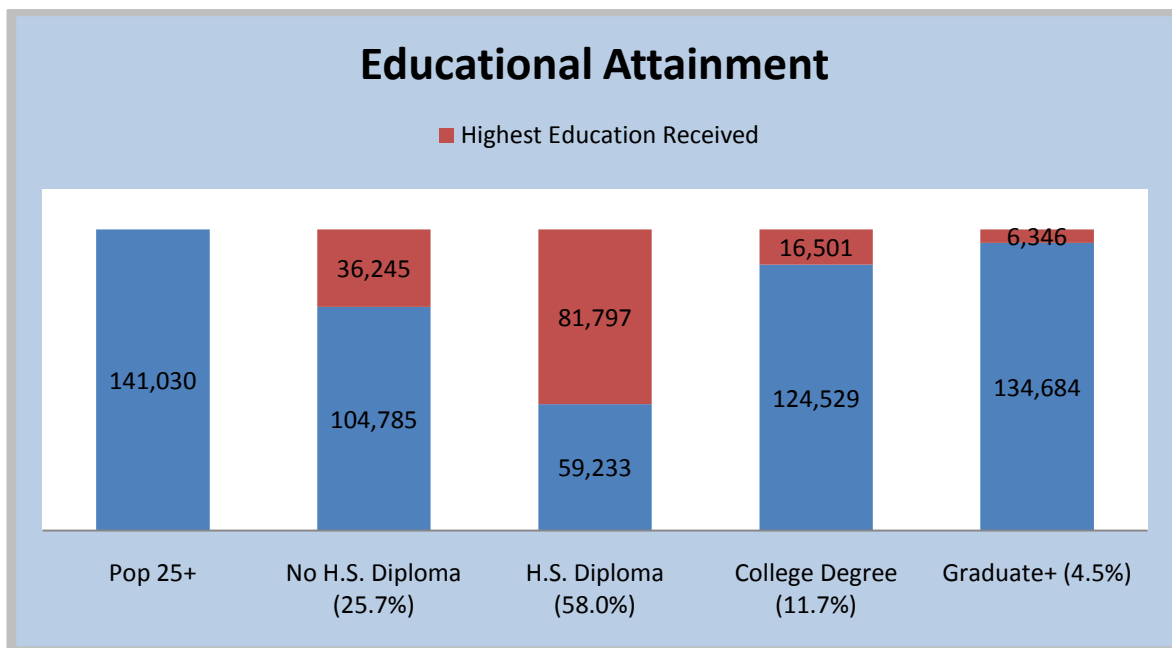
