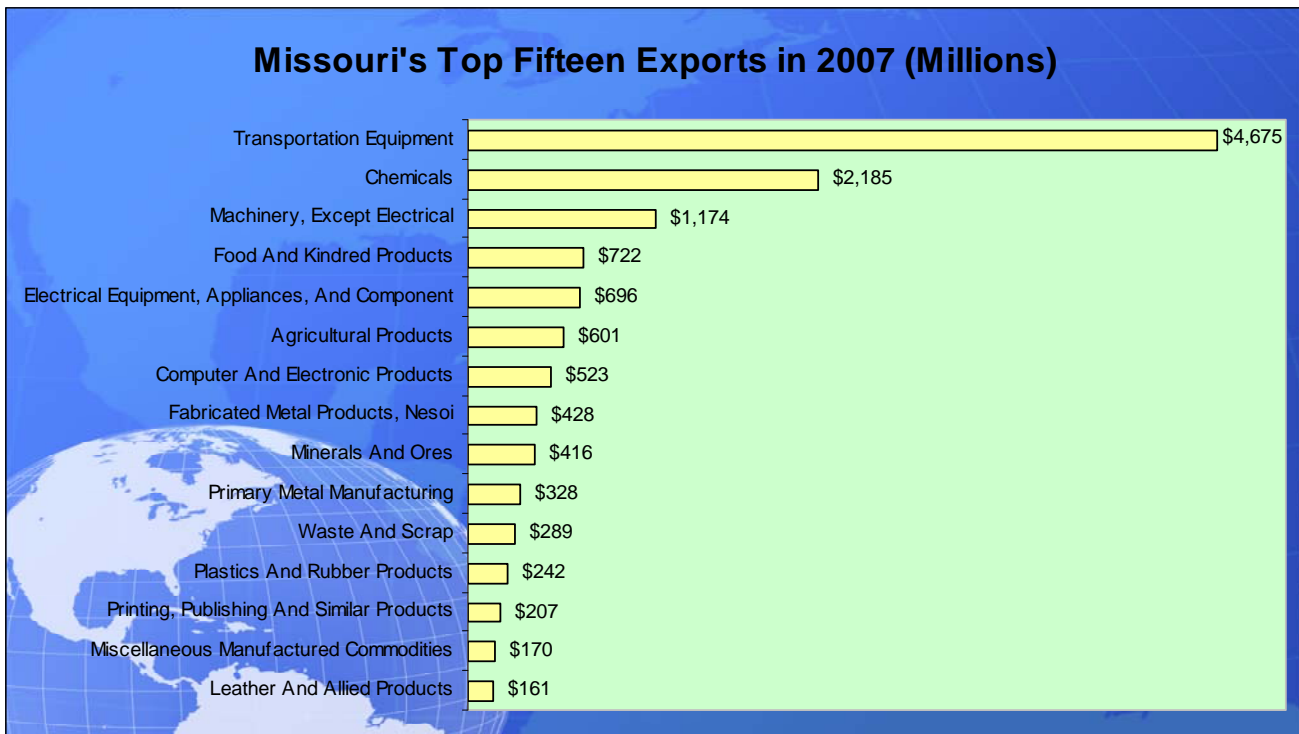


## 2007 MISSOURI EXPORT FACTS

Missouri's exports for 2007 were up 5 percent compared to 2006 according to World Institute for Strategic Economic Research (WISER).

Through the end of December 2007, exports by Missouri companies totaled \$13.4 billion, compared to \$12.8 billion in 2006. This marks the third year in a row Missouri has set a new export record.

Fifteen Missouri product categories each topped \$100 million in export sales through the end of 2007, including transportation equipment (\$4.7 billion), chemicals (\$2.0 billion), machinery (\$1.1 billion), food and kindred products (\$722 million), electrical equipment (\$696 million), agricultural products (\$601 million), computer and electronic products (\$523 million), fabricated metal products (\$428 million), minerals and ores (\$416 million), primary metal manufacturing (\$328 million), waste and scrap (\$289 million), plastics and rubber (\$242 million), printing, publishing and similar products (\$207 million), miscellaneous manufactured (\$170 million), and leather and allied products (\$161 million).



Thirteen of Missouri's top fifteen export product categories increased global sales in 2007. Agricultural products (+125 percent), Minerals and Ores (+19 percent), Electrical Equipment (+18 percent), and Primary Metal manufacturing (+14 percent) led the way in increased product sales. Top product areas with decreases were Waste and Scrap (-20 percent) and Transportation Equipment (-6 percent).
