Introduction

The Missouri JobCrawler is a powerful online employment search tool providing the job seeker immediate access to detailed information on thousands of jobs from a variety of online job banks, corporate web sites, regional hospitals, local newspapers, and government sites. The “spider” and job matching technology is currently used successfully by several state agencies and local workforce investment boards across the country.

Features to help job seekers and students within the system include:



- Assess your job skills, set goals, and research training providers
- Review available jobs and apply online
- Track your job search efforts sent to a personal profile folder online
- Research regional labor market information, such as salaries

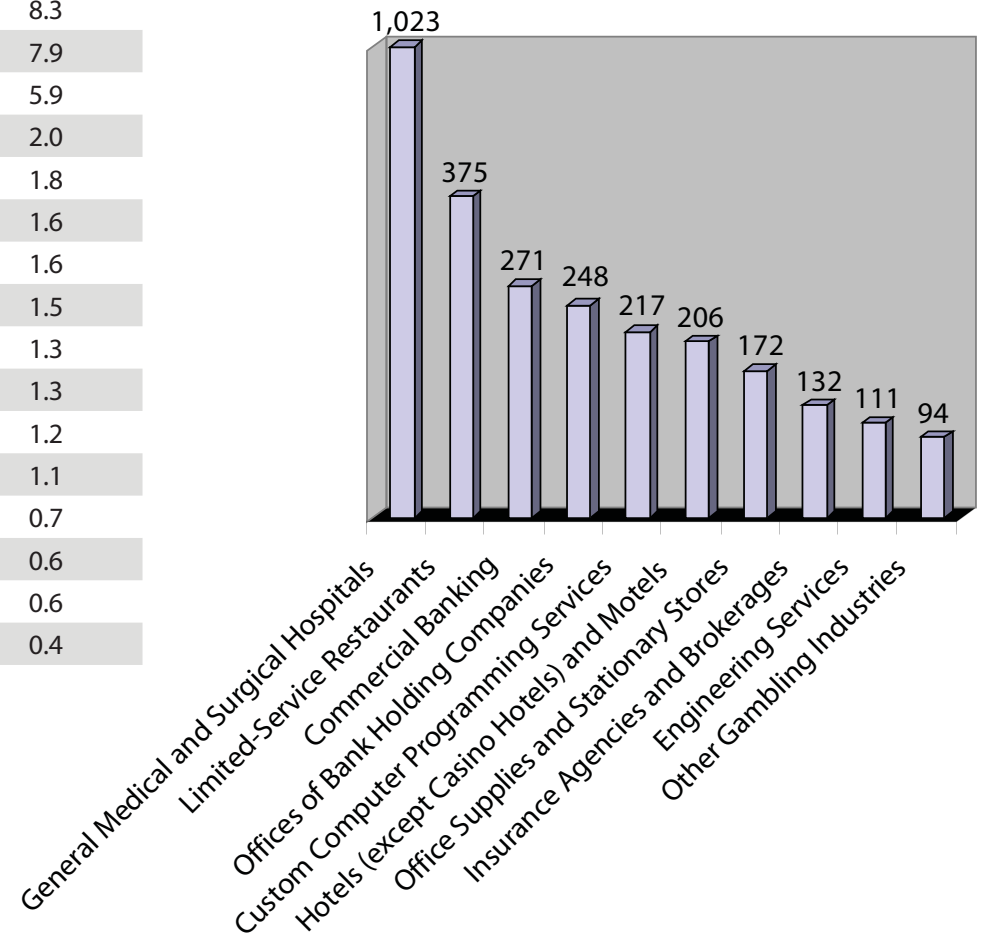

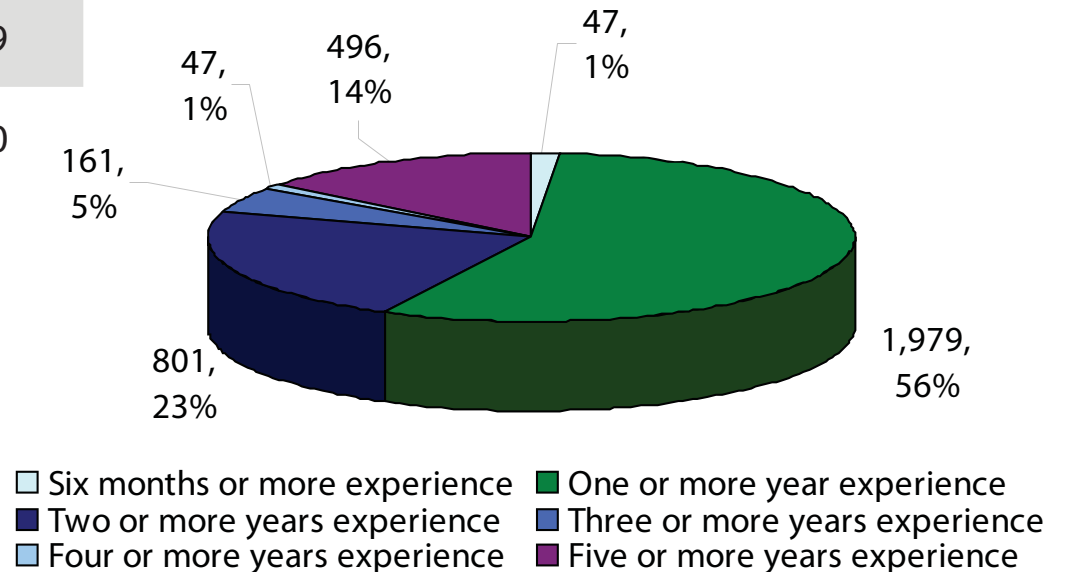

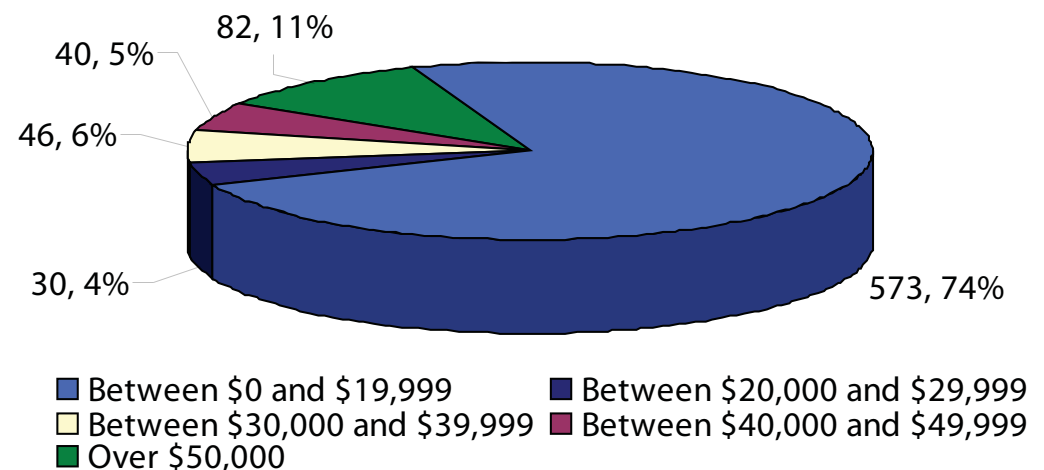
