

2008 Non-Manufactured Goods Export Facts

Missouri's Non-Manufactured Goods exports through the year of 2008 were up 12.6 percent compared to 2007 (34.3) according to World Institute for Strategic Economic Research (WISER).

Through the end of December 2008, Non-manufactured Goods exports totaled (1.6 billion), compared to (1.4 billion) in 2007. This is the second year in a row Missouri has set an export record for Non-Manufactured goods.

Four Missouri non-manufactured product categories each topped \$50 million in export sales through the end of 2008, including agricultural products (738 million), waste and scrap (451 million), minerals and ore (331 million) and special classification provisions (61 million) .

The export data was compiled and analyzed by the foreign trade unit of WISER, based on information received from the U.S. Census Bureau, Foreign Trade Division.
