



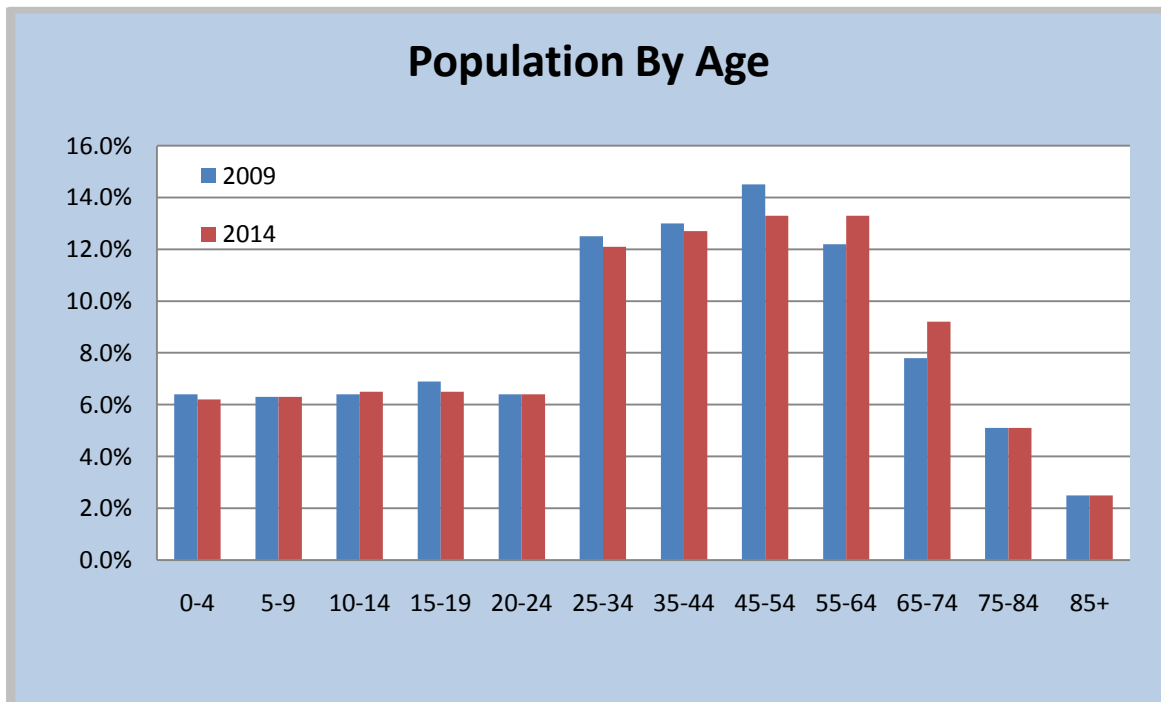
Southeast WIA Region Demographic Summary

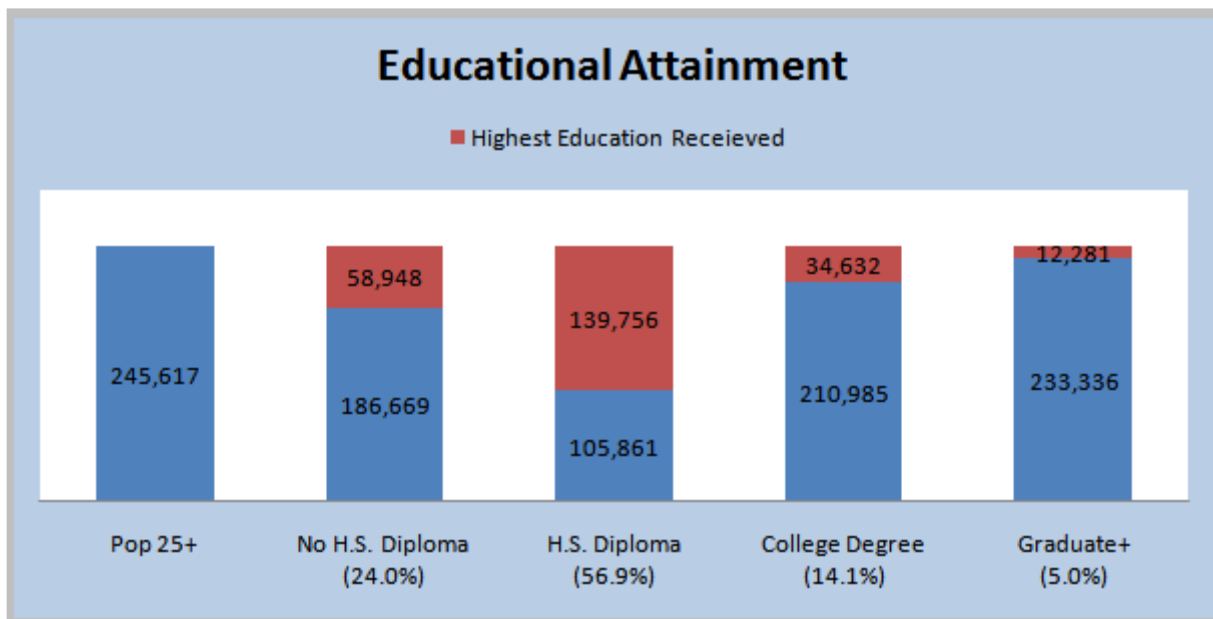
